## SERVE' ACES (Stuff to Know)

## **Court Set Up:**

- Pop up the net
- Use provided painter's tape to mark out court. Guidance marks are already in place.

## Team Ambassadors will exchange their lineups with provided score sheets

- Teams will play 3 rounds of doubles, first to 21 points (by 1). You do NOT need to be the serving team to win a point.
- You can play with as few as 3 players and as many as 6. You CANNOT play with the same partner twice. For instance, if you only have 3 players (A, B, C) the partnerships would be AB, AC, BC

Notate players' names and scores (by total points) for each round on the score sheet. Total points won, with 63 being max possible score, will determine the match.

## **Rules:**

- Play rock, paper, scissors to determine who serves to start each round.
- Alternate servers: Team 1A, Team 2A, Team 1B, Team 2B serving on same side of the net but alternating from right side to left side.
- Change sides of the net every 8 points (after all players have served)
- Ball must bounce before being hit including the serve. Taking the ball out of the air will result in loss of point
- If the ball lands on the line, the call is good. The ball must bounce outside of the line to be out.
- After match is complete, please place net in bag and take equipment inside.

Once all 3 doubles lines are played, team Ambassadors will take a pic of the score sheet and text to Amy Brandon at 704-746-2897.

In the event of rain, please schedule the makeup on your own to be played within 2 weeks on any day both Ambassadors agree upon with bar approval of chosen date. If the match has been started, you must keep the same players. If not, any player can play in the rain make up. Please notify Amy at 704-746-2897 of the rescheduled date so the system can be updated.
