

After much deliberation by our Management Committee, it has been decided that USTA NC will follow the posted policy for NC Adult League refunds without modification, as reproduced below.

NC ADULT LEAGUES REFUND POLICY

League with Local League Play: Refund requests for Local Fees and State Head Tax charges must be made to the Local League Coordinator prior to the team's first scheduled match. Requests must be made in writing. The TennisLink fee is non-refundable. The Local League Coordinator will hold all requests and submit one list to the State League Coordinator by the refund deadline. One check will be sent to the LLC or CTA, who will issue individual checks to the players. Any team dropping out of a league after Initial Roster Deadline for that league will forfeit any registration fees paid and a grievance may be filed.

League with direct advancement to State Championships: Refund requests for Local Fees and State Head Tax charges must be made to the Local League Coordinator prior to the Deadline to Add a Team Advancing Directly to State Championship as noted in the chart in II. F. in the USTA North Carolina League Tennis Regulations. Requests must be made in writing. The TennisLink fee is non-refundable. The Local League Coordinator will hold all requests and submit one list to the State League Coordinator by the refund deadline. One check will be sent to the LLC or CTA, who will issue individual checks to the players.

The process for requesting refunds will also remain the same as posted in the policy above. There are to be no individual requests directly to USTA-NC for refunds.

It is important to note that there are three components to league fees:

- A TennisLink usage fee of \$3.00 at sign-up which is not refundable.
- A USTA-NC head tax of \$6.00 which will be refunded if requested in the manner designated in the policy.
- A local league fee in varying amounts which is refundable according to the local league's policy.

If a refund to players is requested through the local league process, USTA-NC will follow the standard policy regarding refunds of the head tax to the LLC or CTA.

Please note the following interpretations will apply as to what constitutes a “**team's first scheduled match**”:

- On the day play was suspended, matches not played were no longer considered “scheduled” and a refund may be requested.
- If the first scheduled match occurred before play was suspended but was rained out, no refund may be requested.
- If the first possible date of play was originally scheduled after the suspension, a refund may be requested.
