## COVID - 19 and Lake Norman Tennis Association ("LNTA") Protocols and Procedures for USTA League

The LNTA USTA League protocols and procedures around COVID-19 will be in accordance with following recommendations and guidance for safe play from USTA, state and local government and health authorities, and the Centers for Disease Control.

## **Participants**

- Players are advised to review the information provided by the USTA in preparing to play; and specifically, players who have been in contact with someone with COVID-19 in the last 10 days or who are exhibiting any symptoms of the coronavirus must follow the information provided: <u>Before Playing</u>, <u>While Playing</u> and <u>After Playing</u>
- Players are advised to review the flyer posted on the USTA website: <u>Playing Tennis Safely: Player</u>
  <u>Tips and Recommendations</u>
- Players must adhere to information listed below under Host Facilities

## Reporting

- In addition to following guidelines provided by health authorities, the LNTA requests that players who test positive for COVID-19 during the season inform their team captain.
- The LNTA requests that the team captain inform the USTA League Coordinator (adults@Inta.org) of such reports so we can consider appropriate steps, consistent with guidelines from health authorities, which may include notifying teammates and captains of opposing teams who might have come into contact with that player through scheduled team matches or organized team practices.

## **Host Facilities**

- Players must adhere to the procedures and protocols communicated by the host facilities
